

Travel Grant Opportunities Spring 2025

Hanken invites personal grant applications from researchers, doctoral researchers, students and recently graduated alumni. The grants are funded by the Hanken Support Foundation. **Please note that applicants who have also applied for external funding for the same purpose will be prioritised if funding is limited** (for more information on external funding opportunities please see the <u>https://blogs.hanken.fi/research-funding-blog/</u>).

- Researchers (working time at least 50% with permanent employment contract or fixedterm employment contract at least until 30.6.2026) for the following purposes (strong motivation is required for activities outside Europe):
 - Activities abroad i.e. conferences and courses
 - Research visits at a foreign university or research institute (maximum 3 months)
 - Further professional and pedagogical education abroad
 - $\circ~$ Other purposes for travelling abroad e.g. promoting research and teaching at Hanken
- Doctoral researchers (within the regular length of the doctoral programme) for the following purposes (strong motivation is required for grant awards for activities outside Europe):
 - o Activities abroad i.e. conferences, courses, tutorials, and colloquiums
 - Research visits at a foreign university or research institute
 - Other purposes for travelling abroad within the scope of doctoral studies at Hanken
- BSc students, MSc students and alumni (graduated from Hanken within the last three years) for the following purposes in European countries where German, Spanish or Portuguese are generally spoken (only in exceptional cases in Latin America):
 - Language courses
 - Summer & Winter Schools (for BSc and MSc students only, not alumni)
